Message from the CEO

Dear Friends.

I am pleased to report that Maryville is addressing the need to increase access to care for those struggling with the disease of addiction. On February 23rd, we opened Maryville at Post House, a 48-bed inpatient program offering inpatient addiction and co-occurring disorders withdrawal management (detox), short- and long-term residential treatment programs for men at 610 Pemberton-Browns Mills Road in Pemberton, NJ. With the opening of Maryville at Post House, we now offer a total of 124 inpatient beds with 31 withdrawal management, 87 short-term, and six long-term residential treatment beds for addiction and co-occurring disorders in Williamstown and Pemberton. NJ. Maryville offers medication assisted treatment (MAT) at both of these sites and at Maryville's outpatient locations and is, in fact, the largest provider of Vivitrol in the state of New Jersey.

Maryville also just received its licensure to open a new community-based outpatient facility in Northfield, Atlantic County, NJ. Through this new venture, we will co-locate with a physician group offering suboxone and other medical services for community residents. The Maryville Northfield location will extend Maryville's continuum of community care offering intensive outpatient, outpatient, and co-occurring treatment programs for abstinence-based and MAT populations. With this addition, Maryville community- based co-occurring treatment services will be offered in Turnersville, Vineland and Northfield. Please look for an announcement in the near future on the opening date of our Northfield office.

We have invested in our facilities at both the Williamstown and Pemberton locations. At Williamstown, you will see a beautifully landscaped campus and updates to our admissions building, men's facilities, and dining room to improve their comfort and aesthetic appeal. Our Pemberton campus has been updated as well to offer an environment conducive to recovery.

I invite you to participate in our Ride for Recovery on May 6 and see the Williamstown campus for yourself. Our Ride starts at Barb's Harley Davidson in West Collingswood Heights and ends at our Williamstown campus with a BBQ. If you do not ride, we invite you to attend the BBQ only. In addition to the Ride for Recovery, we will have our Race for Recovery on June 24th at Cooper River Park in Camden for both runners and walkers. Registration is now open for both of these events at www.MaryvilleNJ.org.

New Jersey Opioid News Round-Up

Right now, New Jersey is under siege. The opioid crisis is unprecedented in its scope and is devastating families and communities throughout the state.

- In New Jersey, overdose is now the leading cause of accidental death. Almost 6,000 people have died from drug overdoses since 2004.
- In the last decade, admissions to drug treatment programs have risen by 700%.
- The rate of heroin overdose in New Jersey is three times the national average.

Fortunately, New Jersey made great strides in 2017. To combat these alarming statistics, New Jersey enacted legislation to restrict initial prescriptions of opioids to five pills, requiring doctors to talk to patients about the dangers of opioids and calling for stronger addiction service mandates for state-regulated health insurance plans.

Also included in the legislation is a federal, grant-funded, 24-hour response team that police or paramedics can call to help people in addiction. The teams include health providers, substance abuse recovery and mental health advocates, police and medics to provide those suffering from addiction with information and referrals to treatment programs.

These actions represent some of the strongest in the nation and Maryville is proud to be part of the solution to New Jersey's addiction crisis. Our response must be equally broad in scope and intensity. Only together can we assist individuals with a substance use disorder and help restore
